Alice “Jean” Euton, age 86, passed away peacefully in Jackson, Ohio. She was born on March 2, 1940, in Clarksville, Tennessee, to Herbert and Alice May (Harris) Hargrove.

She journeyed to Alaska and Hawaii, and especially cherished her time in Venice, Florida, where she found joy walking the Venice jetty, watching the waves, the wildlife, and her favorite—dolphins—playing in the surf. She also enjoyed golfing and spent many happy hours playing dominoes with friends, sharing laughter and companionship.

Jean was a proud member of the Rotary Club and a devoted member of Calvary Church in Jackson. Her faith, kindness, and warmth touched everyone who had the privilege of knowing her.
