CHARLES ROBERT HILL, JR BORN OCTOBER 2, 1943 WENT HOME TO BE WITH THE LORD ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 16, 2025.

CHARLES WAS THE SON OF THE LATE CHARLES ROBERT HILL, SR AND WANDA (CULP) HILL. AFTER GRADUATING FROM JACKSON HIGH SCHOOL, HE INLISTED IN THE MARINES WHERE HE SERVED DURING THE VIETNAM ERA FROM 10-11-1962 TO 9-8-1966.

AFTER RETURNING HOME FROM THE MARINES HE BECAME EMPLOYEED WITH COLUMBIA FROM WHICH HE RETIRED. CHARLES AND HIS WIFE, SUSAN, BOTH DEDICATED THEIR LIVES TO THE LORD.
