Deloris Jean Parks, age 70 of Jackson, Ohio went home to be with her Lord after an extended illness on Thursday, December 11, 2014. She was born on October 19, 1944 to the late Orville and Nellie (Rodgers) Parks. She graduated with the Jackson High School Class of 1962. She worked for the G.C. Murphy Company for 24 years; 15 years at Super Dollar; and retired from General Mills after 11 years.
