Evelyn Kay (Sagraves) Brady, age 71, of Jackson, passed away on Tuesday, April 9, 2019 at Adena Regional Medical Center in Chillicothe, Ohio. She was born in Gallipolis, Ohio on February 3, 1948 to the late William Bowens and Violet Aileen (Miller) Bowens.
