



Everett "Ev" Edward DeHart

"Ev" (Everett E.) DeHart, age 73, of Jackson OH went ahead on Thursday, March 16, 2023, following a valiant two-year battle with esophageal cancer. Everett was born in Mingo County, WV and moved with his parents to Jackson, OH in the early 1950s. They married and shared a wonderful life for 22 years.

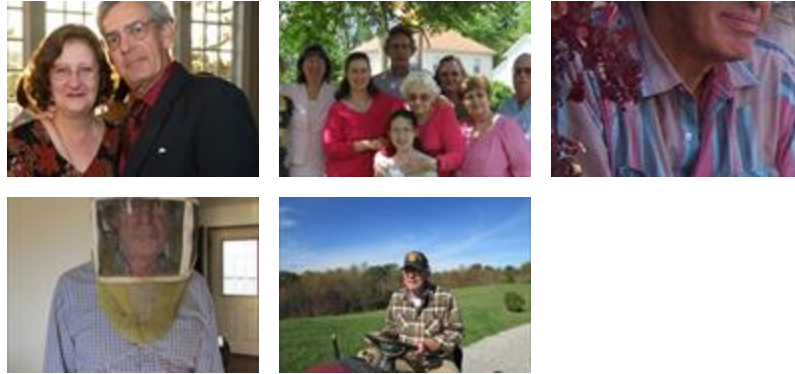
A private burial will be held at the convince of the family at a later date.
