



Floyd Mason Landrum Sr.

March 12, 1938 - January 24, 2025

Floyd Mason Landrum Sr. of Jackson, Ohio, passed away peacefully on January 24, 2025 at Riverside United Methodist Hospital in Columbus, Ohio. He was eighty-six (86) years old. Born to Nellie Leora (Foster) and Walter Scott Landrum, Sr. on March 12, 1938, Floyd was one of seventeen children.

Floyd was a lifelong resident of Jackson, Ohio, with the exception of his time spent in the military. He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Joine (would have been 59 on Feb. 1); son Mason Landrum (Mary); daughter Lori Shaw (Nick); stepson John Grow (Jenn); grandchildren Andy Landrum, Zach and Emma Shaw, Alex, Megan, Harrison and Carson Grow, Jeff Ritchie; great-granddaughter, Zora Grow; and Floyd's last living sibling Charlene Haynes (who passed away 3.5 days after him), as well as many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Floyd was preceded in death by his parents Nellie and Scott Landrum; brothers: Ike, Ivan, John, Paul, Walter (Junior), William (Bill); and sisters: Bernice Sturgill, Clara Mae Reed, Eileen Walker, Frances Landrum, Frieda Lambert, Hazel Collins, Juanita Bolen, Kathleen Foster, and Mary Reed.

Floyd proudly served in the Army from 1961-1963. After his military service, he worked for many years in the road construction industry - primarily for Decker Construction and later for Shelly and Sands, driving to and from

Columbus, 5-6 days a week, in order to best provide for his family.
