Frank L Swingle, age 82 of Jackson, Ohio passed away on Thursday, May 1, 2025 at his home surrounded by his loved ones. He was born on May 21, 1942 in Jackson to the late Otis and Pauline Swingle.

Frank was a proud lifelong member of the Jackson community, where his passion for local traditions and people left a lasting legacy. He became a downtown icon, as he worked for 37 years at City Loan & Savings where he ultimately found himself in management. From here - A devoted supporter of the Jackson Ironmen, his commitment to the team led him to start the Player of the Week program in 1992 originally sponsored by City Loan Financial - highlighting and encouraging young athletes in the spirit of excellence. He had found peace and pride in the simple pleasures of life. But above all, Frank considered his greatest accomplishment to be his family. He was a loving husband, a devoted father, and a proud grandfather and great-grandfather. His legacy lives on through the lives he touched and the values he instilled in all who knew him.

He is survived by his loving wife of 56 years, Linda Swingle; his children, Shannon Swingle of Jackson and TJ (Jill) Conger of Columbus, Ohio; grandchildren, Emily (Garret) McDaniel, Abigail Conger, and Matthew Conger; great grandchildren, Hardy and Averie McDaniel; beloved dog, Bernie; as well as several nieces and nephews.
