George E. DeLong, age 74 of Chillicothe, passed away at Heartland of Chillicothe on Friday, March 15, 2019. He was born in Jackson, Ohio on May 9, 1944 to the late Harley "Pete" DeLong, Sr., and Georgia (DeLong) Rippeth.

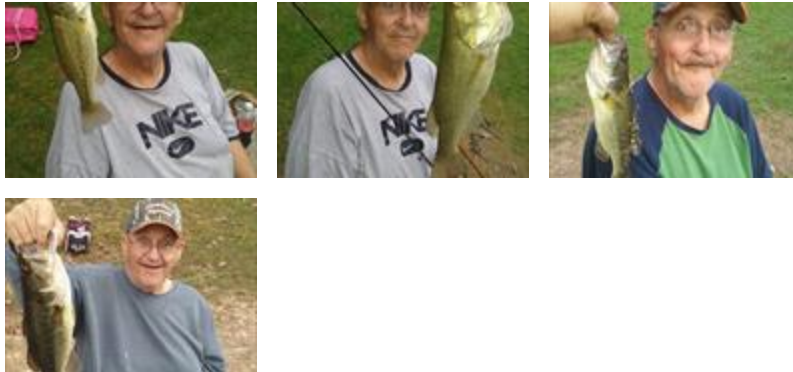
