



## Isaac "Ike" Landrum

January 7, 1937 - April 11, 2023

Isaac (Ike) Landrum of Jackson, Ohio passed peacefully on April 11, 2023 at the Holzer Medical Center. Born to Nellie Leora (Foster) and Walter Scott Landrum, Sr on January 7, 1937, Ike was one of seventeen children. He was eighty-six (86) years old. Ike was a lifelong resident of Jackson County with the exception of his time spent in the military.
