January 25, 1949 - June 6, 2023

After 74 years of life, James "Jim" Andrew Adams went home to be with his Lord and Savior on June 6, 2023. Many people will remember him by his caring heart and quick wit – there was never a time that he wasn't trying to make others laugh. Jim was born on January 25, 1949 and was raised in Richmond Dale, Ohio by his parents Jim and Ethel Adams, along with his two sisters Darlene Lott and Donna Adams, and brother Ernie Adams (all deceased). He was a graduate of Southeastern High School's class of 1967, and soon after trained as a diesel mechanic before becoming a proud Veteran of the Vietnam War, serving as a helicopter mechanic in the Army. Since that time Jim found joy in fixing things; he worked in many different roles such as a custodian, mechanic, carpenter, maintenance man, boiler operator, and eventually retired from the Refrigeration Department at General Mills – his family and friends coined him as a "jack of all trades". He also had many hobbies like wood working, painting cars, racing on the dirt track, and riding motorcycles. In fact, he was a member of the Redeemed Riders Chapter of the Christian Motorcycle Association, serving two years as Vice-President and one year as President. Above all else though, he loved spending time with his family, helping others, and serving the Lord. Jim was a devoted man of Christ, and a member of World Outreach Ministries in Wellston, Ohio.

Jim is survived by his loving wife, Carolyn Adams, who he was happily married to for thirty-one years. He had four beloved children: Lori (Morton) Wilburn, Tanya (Bobby) Gee, Mike (Christina) Adams, Candice (Randy)

Kennedy, and also raised his niece Sarah (Johnathon) Gillum-Campbell as his very own.
