Jennifer Renee Hutchinson, age 42 of Wellston, Ohio passed away on Monday, May 18, 2026, surrounded by her loved ones. Jennifer was born on September 11, 1983, in Athens, Ohio.

Jennifer was a lifelong resident of the Jackson County area, growing up in Jackson and making a home of her own in Wellston for most of her adult life. 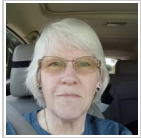
