Joseph Leroy Tanner Sr "Buddy" age 82 of Jackson, Ohio passed away peacefully at Grant Medical Center in Columbus, Ohio on November 27, 2024 following a tragic accident. He was born in Jackson, Ohio on September 4, 1942 to the late Hearl Alfred Tanner and Hester Tanner (Zimmerman). On July 15, 1991 he married Daisy Irene Hoosier who survives.
