



## Kenneth Gene Rawlins

Kenneth Gene Rawlins, 83, of Jackson, was called home on Tuesday, October 10, 2023.

Kenny was born on February 17, 1940 in Firebrick, Ohio, to Guy Thomas Rawlins and Garnet Irene (Jenkins, Rawlins) Wyatt. He spent his early years in Detroit, Michigan, returning to Ohio in 1947.

Kenny graduated from Coalton High School in 1959. He married Connie Lou Jenkins on May 28, 1959.

Kenny was a multi-skilled 'jack-of-all trades,' building and remodeling several homes and rental properties in the county. Whether pouring the footer and laying the foundation, to finishing the plumbing, wiring, roofing or building custom cabinetry, he worked with his hands tirelessly.

He spent many hours in the garage sanding, priming and painting cars and enjoyed traveling to various car shows on the weekends.
