Kyoko "Alice" Kato Chinn, age 98, passed away on September 20, 2025. She was born in Nagoya, Japan. She worked at Komaki Air Force Base for the U.S. Air Force from 1945 -1954 as a translator, bookkeeper, and typist. While there, she met Jack Chinn. They married in 1954 and have resided in Jackson since 1958.

Alice worked at the Jackson, Ohio Goodyear Corporation for 32 years, where she received the Goodyear 30 Year Award, the Perfect Attendance Award, and the Safety Award. She worked in the Finance, Engineering, Quality Control and Production Departments. She was a member of the Jackson Senior Citizen Club where she served as Vice President and was the Senior Citizen Apple Festival Queen in 1999. She was a member of the Christ United Methodist Church. Her favorite hobby was making handicrafts for her family and friends.
