



## Laurence Eugene Jackson

July 31, 1927 - January 8, 2023

Laurence Eugene Jackson, age 95 of Oak Hill, passed away on Sunday January 8th at the VA Medical Center in Chillicothe. He was born in Jackson on July 31, 1927 to the late Leslie Stonewall Jackson and Florence (Barlow) Jackson. Besides his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Ann (Bush) Jackson, and by his sisters: Juanita Woodruff, Leona Humphrey and Julie Brewer.

He is survived by his daughter, Trisha M. (Scott) Conley; son, Gene A. (Ronda) Bush; along with several grand and great-grandchildren.

He was a proud veteran of the US Navy – serving in both WWII and Korea. He served aboard the USS Hornet (CV-12). He was a lifetime member of the NRA, Masons, VFW and Moose. He retired from DT&I Railroad, where he only missed three days of work in his 35 years there. He was the first cab driver in Jackson County in 1945. He toured the world in 1954. He could build or fix anything and enjoyed shooting and motorcycles. On his deathbed he witnessed Jesus' salvation.

Graveside services will be held at Fairmount Cemetery at 11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, January 11th with Arvil Murray Jr. officiating. Military honors will be provided by Chapter 45 – Disabled American Veterans. Visitation will be held at the Mayhew-Brown Funeral Home prior to the graveside service on
