He could tell you all the facts about each and every one of them. He was a collector of swords, daggers, and knives as well.

In his younger years, Mykel was secretly a Backstreet Boys fan. Only it wasn't a secret, because Mykel was ALWAYS singing it. So eventually, he was

openly a fan, but mainly because everyone already knew anyway. There was no shame in his Backstreet Boys game.

Mykel spent his very last day earth side making memories with his boy, Ian and some other members of his family. Memories they will cherish forever.
