



Stanley Bagnall

April 25, 1924 - May 25, 2020

Stanley (NMI) Bagnall, age 96 of Gainesville, Georgia, passed away peacefully on Monday, May 25, 2020. He was born in Bradenton, Florida on April 25, 1924 to the late Stanley Amos Parker and Pauline Roesch Bagnall.

He is preceded in death by his first wife, Thelma Fern (Smith) Bagnall and a son, Stanley Alexander Bagnall, and stepfather Walter D. Bagnall.

He is survived by his wife, Suzanne (Pierce) Bagnall, and his sons: Benjamin (Virginia) Bagnall of Wheelersburg, Ohio and Walter (Deborah) Bagnall of Chillicothe, Ohio. Stanley was a veteran of the US Army Air Corps, serving as a second lieutenant with the 5th Air Force in the Pacific Theater during World War II. In 1947, he joined Delta Airlines as a pilot, retiring as Captain. For a number of years afterward, he continued in general aviation as a pilot and instructor. In 2005 he earned the FAA Master Pilot Award.

He had been active as one of Jehovah's Witnesses since 1968.
